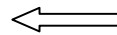

PART I: MINISTRY ACCOMPLISHMENTS

1. What projects or outreach events did your ministry center accomplish during this month? Include project description, date, place held, and attendance.



In August we continued assisting our satellite office in the city of Matagalpa. We visited the office with the purpose of supervise in site the activities and also the administrative way that our volunteers are managing our office in this city. We noticed that there are more people who are familiar with the LHM activities in the North of the country. We also set up internet access for better communication. We also could share some clothes that our Brothers from OGT donated.



We also visited the city of Granada bringing our assistance in high and elementary schools. We had meeting with Pr. Guillermo who is supporting us with the booklets distribution in this city and in same time these booklets allow him to continue reaching people and contacting members for his congregation in Granada. We also supported his congregation with some clothes offered by OGT.



In the strategy alliances we participated with the AIDS Association that organized an activity where they offered medical test for AIDS for all those who want to be sure that they are not infected with this pandemic. LHM-Nicaragua assisted them with printing materials concerning this illness and also offered Bibles Courses and free psychological attention offer by our psychologist volunteers in our office.



We went into the streets for more direct attention to the people in their home, in a campaign door to door we distributed our monthly booklets with topics that are very interesting for the people

who need spiritual advises.



We received many requests concerning topics of the daily problems that our society is facing in this moment, like about illness, loneliest between others.



During this month we visited many communities assisting the volunteers that are teaching our Bible Courses in the rural communities where about 500 people between kids, young people and adults are participating in the classes that we are teaching along the weeks.



We still teaching English Classes as a second language in our main office. It is a program that we offer with the purpose of teach the English language as a skill for the young people and also our objective is to reach more young people with the Message of salvation using this tool.

During this month we were distributing an interesting booklet titled "Bulimia and Anorexia", it was very good received and requested material, special from young

people in the universities, some of them commented us that it is a good information that is touching the real life of some girls even young man that are worry about their physical beauty not mare that they are in risk.



We still bringing the Message of Jesus Christ transmitting our signal in the Internet with our Radio on line, "Radio Cristo Nica" is receiving many visitors that are reporting our signal and also congratulating us for the success that we are having when they listen our Message. The visitors have the possibility also to contact us directly using the chat area in the same page. Some of



them who are originally from Nicaragua are contacting us and sending greeting to their relatives who live here and they also listen our Radio on line.

Young people connecting young people, it is our slogan to bring the Gospel and noting better to do with the tools that they like.

Xochil is one of the young girl volunteer that every day sits in front of the computer for a while sending Christian Messages and advices through the Text messages for the

cellular phones that we get from young people who visit our office and want to continue receiving this important information.

Mary is a young girl that finished her University study; she spent more than five year in the city of Leon where she attended the medicine faculty. Mary is originally from Matagalpa, she explained us that once she was walking in the street when she saw our advertisement in the satellite office, she came in to the office and very happy told our volunteers that during her University year, she always found very good advices and support while she read our monthly booklets special when she was far away from her hometown. She said thanks you for continue sharing and covering more places in Nicaragua where people is needing the spiritual assistance.

What major ministry or projects will you be working on in the next month?

September is the month of the independence when Nicaragua was separated from the Spanish colonizers. During this month we will support the students who are JOEL members in the different dynamic and activities. (They have band parade, OGT donated some beautiful band uniform that they put on very proud during the marching bands.)

We are going to distribute between the different pastors, congregations and public in general our monthly booklet titled "Life is Better". We send them to Granada, Jinotepe, Chinandega, Matagalpa, Jinotega, and all the communities in Leon.

Our Regional Area Counselor Mr. Nilo Figur is going to visit LHM-Nicaragua at the end of September. We are going to prepare a schedule of visits with our LHM leaders and also with the Church member of the ILSN (Lutheran Church Nicaragua Synod). We will visit also the satellite office in Matagalpa city, which is about 60 mile from the capital city Managua.

These and other administrative tasks we are going to carry out in September.

These and other activities were carried out during August like Mr. Francisco Urbina who is the external auditor finished the LHM Audit and according his report all is well, thanks God our recourses and administrative procedures are well managed by our office staff.
