Include project description, date, place held, and attendance.

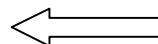

Mr. Nilo Figur also participated in a meeting with Pastors and deaconesses who are member of the Lutheran Church Nicaragua Synod and with the missionary in charge from LCC Dr. Mayan. Mr. Nilo received direct information from Pastors who commented that they are receiving support from our local office.

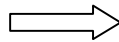

and programs.



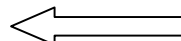
We carried out a drawing contest in our satellite office in Matagalpa, where the kids who are participating in the Bible Courses showed their understanding about the Gospel through the drawings.
