Bible Reading Schedule

This Lenten season we see Jesus identify Himself as the God Who revealed Himself as "I AM" to Moses at the burning bush (Exodus 3:14). Jesus identifies Himself in the great "I AM" statements in the Gospels. In our Bible reading schedule this month we read one of those "I AM" statements in the Gospel of Mark. Jesus is being questioned at His "trial" by the Jewish Sanhedrin. The High Priest asks Jesus if He is the Messiah, the Christ, the Son of God. And Jesus said, "I AM!" (Mark 14:62) The Jewish leaders understood the fact that Jesus had called Himself God, but they didn't believe He was God. So they wrongly accused Him of blasphemy and sentenced Him to death on the cross. Christ took up the cross for us that by His suffering, death, and resurrection we might be saved, and be able to say, "I am a believer". I am a Christian. I am forgiven and saved in Christ." (Mark 8:34-38; 14-16; I Corinthians 15; Galatians 3)
