## **BIBLE READING SCHEDULE**

Fireworks are a popular and exciting way to celebrate the 4th of July. Many cities hold fireworks displays to celebrate the 4th. The bright lights and the loud booms remind us of the battles which were fought to secure our country's freedoms.

Isaiah too was privileged to see wondrous things as he saw God sitting on His heavenly throne (Isaiah 6). In this encounter, Isaiah was set free from his sins to preach the Gospel. In Isaiah's preaching he proclaimed the virgin birth of Christ (Isaiah 7:14; Matt. 1:22-24); Christ's epiphany to the Gentiles (Isaiah 11:10; 60:1-7; Matthew 2:1-11; Romans 15:12); the ministry of John the Baptist (Isaiah 40:1-5; Luke 3:1-6) Christ's suffering and death (Isaiah 50:6; 52:13-53:12).

As you read Isaiah's book in the monthly Bible reading schedule, look for Christ in the above passages and many more. You will be assured that His grace is sufficient to cleanse you of all your sins.
