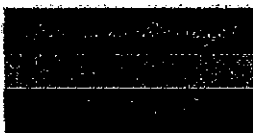

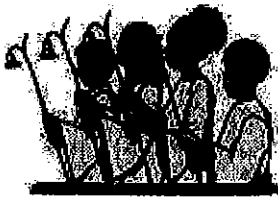


BIBLE READING SCHEDULE

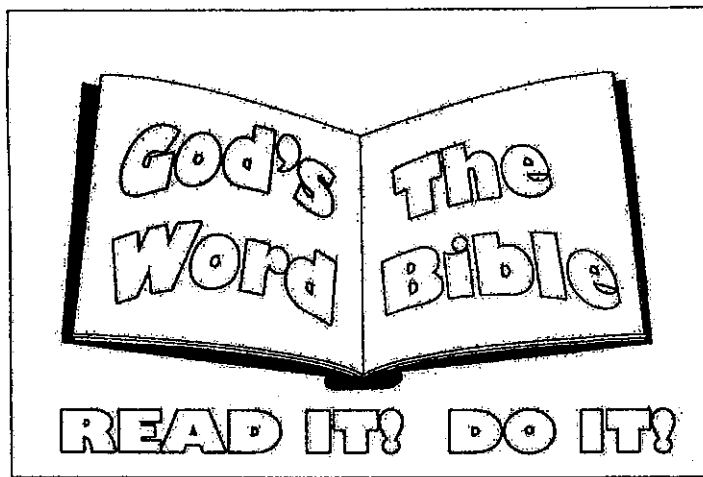

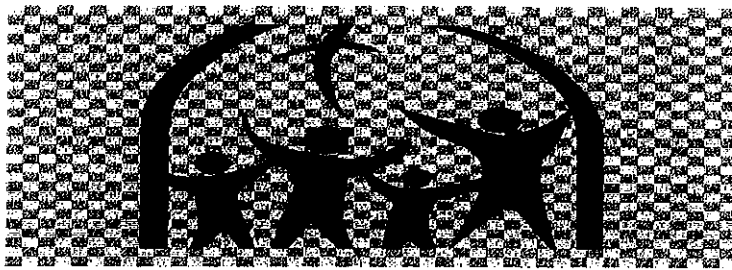
